

(Draft Ordinance: November 18, 2015)

WHEREAS, paragraph b, Section 13 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, confers power to the Sangguniang Panlungsod to name or, change the name of its barangays, as well as its local facilities such as public places, streets and structures;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Resolution No. 21, S. 2015 of Barangay Dadiangas North, this city, requests this august body the renaming of existing Manga Street into Antonio G. Bautista Jr. Street on the ground that the latter was the first elected Punong Barangay of Dadiangas North, General Santos City since 1994 up to 2007 of unbroken service;

WHEREAS, with the exemplary tract records the late Antonio G. Bautista, Jr. had bequeathed both to government and community services during his lifetime, it is but fitting and proper to be commended and acknowledged the late Antonio G. Bautista, Jr. by renaming Manga Street after him;

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING MANGA STREET IN BARANGAY DADIANGAS NORTH, THIS CITY TO ANTONIO G. BAUTISTA, JR. STREET IN HONOR AND RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTION OF THE FIRST ELECTED PUNONG BARANGAY OF BARANGAY DADIANGAS NORTH, THIS CITY.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of General Santos, that:

Section 1. The present Manga Street in Barangay Dadiangas North, this city is hereby changed to Antonio G. Bautista, Jr. Street.

Section 2. **Separability Clause.** If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 3. **Repealing Clause.** All ordinances, resolutions, orders, circulars, memoranda and other similar issuances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 3. **Effectivity Clause.** This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in any newspaper of general circulation within the city.
